ALBANY - Scott M. Morley, 54 of Albany, passed away suddenly of natural causes on February 16, 2023.



Scott enlisted in the Marine Corps where he served six years. He deployed to South America and the Middle East and participated in operations in Cuba and Somalia. He earned the rank of corporal and received an honorable discharge. Scott received his bachelor's degree from SUNY Albany and juris doctorate degree from Thomas M. Cooley Law School. Scott practiced law for 20 years in the Capital Region at the Morley Law Firm and formerly with Martin Shudt.

He is survived by his mother, Elizabeth of Annapolis, Md.; his beloved wife, Nancy, and his sons, Owen and Mack of Albany. He is also survived by his sisters, Margaret (Jamie) of Phoenix, Ariz., and Sarah (Charles) of Mahomet, Ill.; his brother, James (Libby) of Odenton, Md.; and his nieces and nephews, Charlies, George, Kial, Margaret, Lucas, and Presley. ×
